

SKIING MAUNA KEA

Mauna Kea (Hawaiian for 'white mountain') is the tallest mountain in the world, measured from its undersea base of -19,000' to the 13,796' summit. This massive extinct volcano is blessed with some of the finest snow in the world, sometimes covering almost 100 square miles of ski able terrain. Hawaiian skiers call the springlike snow 'Pineapple Powder'.

You must have a 4-wheel drive vehicle to get to the summit - there are no lifts, no grooming and no resort. Skiers each take turns picking up other skiers at the bottom of the runs and driving them to the summit. Conditions can be treacherous with ice,

wind crust and runs that turn abruptly into razor sharp lava rock. But when the stars align, runs in excess of two miles for up to 4,500 vertical feet are a possibility. And the unique view from the top straight down to the Pacific is spectacular!

BICYCLING DOWN HALEAKALA

27 miles; 99% downhill - this is the longest downhill bike tour in the world. Take the sunrise tour: sunrise over Haleakala is a thing of extraordinary beauty.

The ride starts just outside the entrance of Haleakala National Park and Haleakala's 10,000 foot summit. Cyclists wend their way through a

series of maybe two dozen switchbacks, the little town of Kula, through a lava moonscape, sugar cane and pineapple fields ending at the ocean. Outfitters for this spectacular journey generally prohibit children under 12, and also suggest it's most suitable for experienced cyclists.

FLY FISHING IN WAIMEA CANYON

The trip to the Waimea River in the Canyon should appear on every serious fly fisherman's 'Bucket List.' Mark Twain called this "The Grand Canyon of the Pacific"; whatever you want to call it, the great gash known as Waimea Canyon is a sight to behold.



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A tremendous earthquake forced a number of streams into the torrent of a single river, a river that carved this Canyon. Its reddish lava beds remind many of the Grand Canyon, albeit smaller - a mile wide, 3,567 feet deep, and 12 miles long. Nowadays, the Waimea is home to rainbow trout up to four pounds or so - but to get to them you have to make a long, strenuous hike to the bottom. Only serious and experienced backpackers need apply!

DIVING MOLOKINI

Molokini is a small volcanic caldera located just a few miles off Maui's shore. Hawaii's only Island Marine Sanctuary, it rises from 300 feet below the ocean's surface and is almost half a mile wide. Its isolation has created a unique underwater experience; water clarity is excellent, with visibility often in excess of 150 feet. Molokini's coral reef is located in the middle of crater, protected from waves and surge.

Snorkelers can encounter around 250 species of endemic fish and marine life. Some of the more common fish include



yellow tang, moorish idol, parrot fish, black triggerfish, bluefin trevally and raccoon butterfly fish. Divers the world over come to Molokini to experience the wall and drift dives available - the backside of Molokini drops nearly straight down to 360 feet. It is suggested that only advanced divers visit the back side of Molokini, and you must be certified to dive here. But if you do, you're likely find many different types of shark, moray eels, manta rays, dolphins, octopus and hundreds of exotic fish.









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
